



New School Serving Grades 6-12 at 91-30 Metropolitan Avenue  
Frequently Asked Questions

When will the new 6-12 school on the Metropolitan campus open?

*The school will open September 2010 and will serve grade 6 and 7 in the first year.*

What is the address of the new 6-12 school on the Metropolitan campus?

*The school will be located at 91-30 Metropolitan Avenue.*

What is the new 6-12 school on the Metropolitan campus going to be called?

*The school's name is to be determined.*

Does the new 6-12 school on the Metropolitan campus have a code?

*A DBN and has not yet been created. We will create them soon.*

What is the process for applying to the new 6-12 school on the Metropolitan Campus?

*6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students in District 28 will be able to apply to the new 6-12 school on the Metropolitan campus for September 2010. The new middle school application is expected to be available in March. Students will be notified of offers to the new school along with their main round offers in May.*

*New middle schools open with Limited Unscreened selection criteria. This means that students who attend an information session or open house receive priority and are considered for placement first. If more students have attended an information session than there are seats in the school, then a computer-based selection process is used.*

*Beginning in 2011-2012, 6<sup>th</sup> grade will be the articulation grade to the middle school.*

Will there be an open house?

*Interested families should check with the school administration regarding scheduled open houses.*

Other than an open house, how can I learn about the new high school to determine whether I want to attend?

*Once the new school has been selected, the new school leader will be engaged in a number of recruitment activities that include direct outreach to elementary schools. Information about these activities will be shared with district elementary schools and made available to families.*
