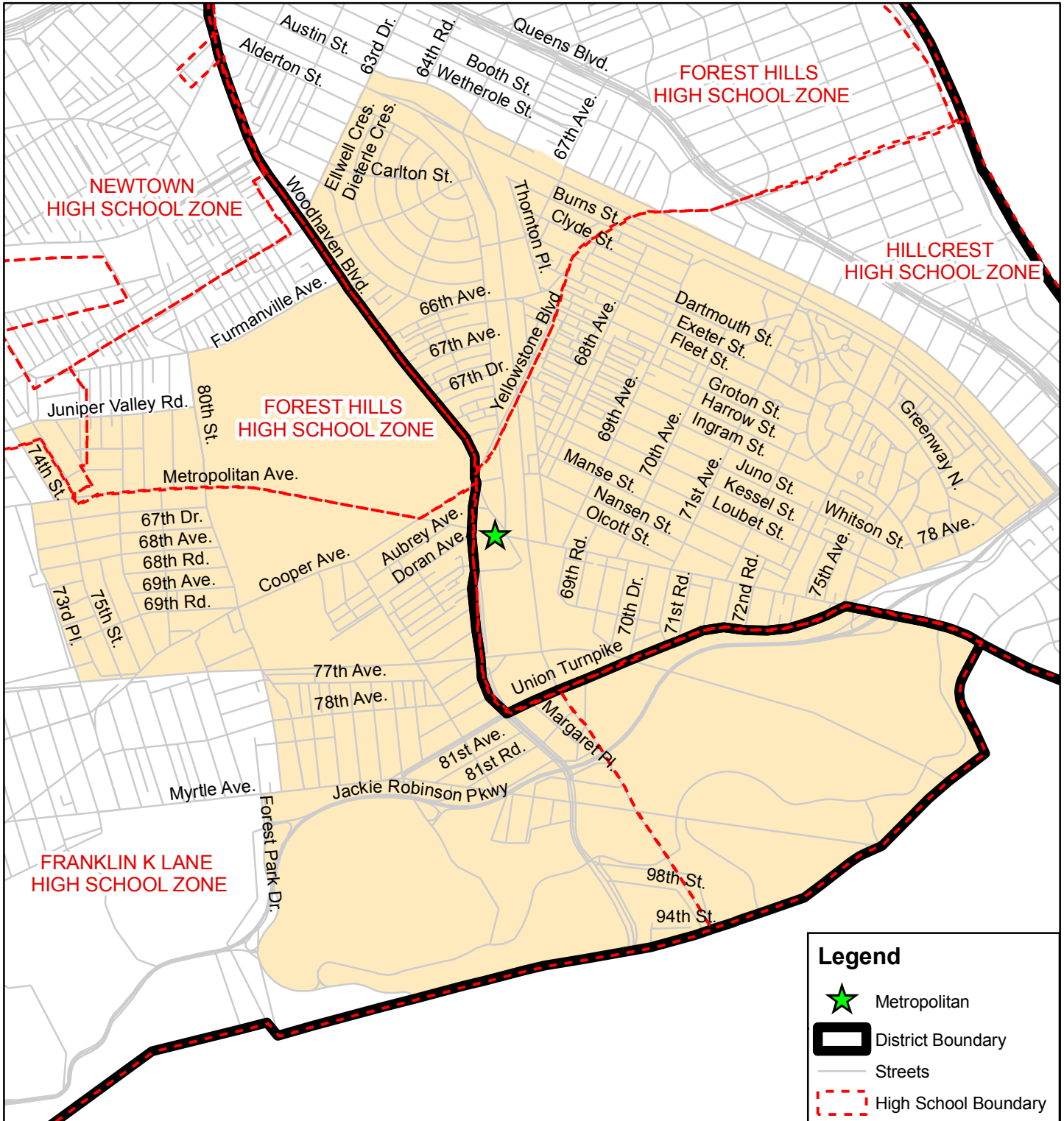


Proposed Zoning Lines for the New High School Located at 91-30 Metropolitan Avenue

Frequently Asked Questions

When will the new high school on the Metropolitan campus open?

The school will open September 2010 and will serve grade 9 in the first year.

What is the address of the new high school on the Metropolitan campus?

The school will be located at 91-30 Metropolitan Avenue.

What is the new high school on the Metropolitan campus going to be called?

The school's name is to be determined.

Does the new high school on the Metropolitan campus have a code?

A DBN and appropriate program codes have not yet been created. The codes will be included in the Directory of New New York City High Schools that will be available in February and distributed at all middle schools.

What is the process for applying to the new high school on the Metropolitan campus?

Parents can indicate their interest in the new high school on the Metropolitan campus on the New High Schools Choice Form that will be available beginning on February 1, 2010. The forms are due to the middle school guidance counselor by February 23, 2010. If a student chooses to submit a New Schools Choice Form this will supersede the December application; the December application becomes null and void. Each student will receive only one match in March.

Who is eligible to apply to the new high school on the Metropolitan campus?

Everyone is eligible to apply but students will be considered in the following priority order:

- *Zoned students*
- *Queens residents*
- *New York City residents*

Since the new school has a defined zone, students who reside in the zone and list the school on their New School Choice Form will be guaranteed admission provided that they are not matched to a higher choice. Students who are not zoned for the school may apply as well but there is no guarantee of admission.

Am I promised a seat if I live near the new high school?

If you are zoned for the school and you list the high school on your New School Choice Form, you are guaranteed a seat provided that you do not get matched to a higher choice. If you are matched to a higher choice, you give up your right to attend your zoned school.

If I become zoned to the new high school, but I want to attend my current zoned school, do I have that option?

For September 2010, students who are rezoned to the Metropolitan campus will maintain priority to both Metropolitan and their current zoned school. Beginning September 2011, students living in the Metropolitan zone will only have zoned priority to Metropolitan.

Once the zone for the new high school is announced, is there an opportunity for public comment?

You can comment on the proposed zone at the November 30, 2009 public meeting, taking place at PS 113 (87-21 79 Avenue) or email the Office of Portfolio Planning at portfolio@schools.nyc.gov.

Will the new high school hold an open house?

Interested families should check with the school administration regarding scheduled open houses.
