- Principal's Report - Ms. Koatz

- State Testing 3rd/4th/5th graders
 - ELA: March 29th 30th
 - Math: April 26th 27th
 - Science (4th grade only): Hands On portion May 25 27th; Multiple
 Choice portion will be on June 6th
 - Make-up days are available
 - State tests are mandated, however, if you are opting out, please let the Testing Coordinator know (Ms. Koatz)
 - There will be no virtual Saturday academy as there are no teachers available to do it
 - Ms. Koatz will hold a Zoom testing meeting for parents (TBC)
- St. Jude's Math-a-thon
