- As member of Education community she's been reaching out to schools to understand needs

- Questions:
- Is 196 getting a crossing guard?
 - Lynn wants to get a crossing guard but she needs to push. She is going to see what the city can do in the short term. They're down resources so even a control car around 2:30 may not be feasible right now. She will circle back with us
- Future of Gifted and Talented program
 - Her position is that there should be G+T in every school. Chancellor wants to expand G+T program but call it something else.
- School Based Mental Health Programs
 - Lynn will make a note and talk to DOE about future of kids mental health programs.
- Speed Bumps around the school / Stop Sign 72nd ave and 112 st
 - Lynn can have DOT look into Stop sign. Speed bumps will not work because
 if a car hits it at high speed they can go into the building. She will get back
 to Alyssa.
- What is going on with old parkway hospital?

- It was supposed to be senior housing but now she's not sure what is going on. She will circle back and also talk to her staff about what can be done about the graffiti.
- Any plans for new Middle School for the area? Will any of the school extensions be used for middle schools?
 - Lynn does not know. She will find out.
- Some concrete is loose by the 196 playground ramp which kids like to play with
 - Lynn will get this looked into
- Lynn can join PA again and would like to invite us and our kids to a town hall coming up.

- Grades K-2
 - ELA 79% of students scored on or above grade level
 - Math 55% scored on or above grade level
- Grades 3-5
 - ELA 74% students scored on or above grade level
 - Math 71% students scored on or above grade level
- Math Intervention specialist is available in the morning for extra help
- Saw floor plans for new wing update
