Minutes of PA Meeting

<u>Board members in attendance</u>: Elizabeth Fassler (Co-President), Renee Ming (Co-President), Ilana Haas (VP), Lindsey Sweedlund (VP), Rachel Bialik (Treasurer), Marina Tasopoulos-Chan (Secretary)

Quorum was achieved. 34 parents were in attendance in person, and approximately 21 parents were in attendance online.

<u>Call to order:</u> The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:30pm by Yvette Jong and Yumi Lee.

Welcome and Board Introduction

<u>Approval of June General Meeting Minutes:</u> The June 2023 minutes were approved by Marina Tasopoulos-Chan and Ying Lai.

Principal's Report:

Mrs. Migliano

We have had a great opening to the school year. Thank you to parents who helped deliver school supplies to classrooms this summer.

Scheduling: Last year we had more staffing available in the hallway. This year, students enter the building at 8:25 because of safety issues related to the availability of staffing in the hallways. Contractually the teachers don't start the day until 8:30.

Our new CEP goal highlights will be sent home to parents soon.

Class size & enrollment: The DOE maximum class size is capped at 25 students in kindergarten, and 32 students in grades 1-5. Current class sizes in our school are tied to funding.

New curriculum in ELA and math: This year we will be using HMH Into Reading and enVision Mathematics. Parent workshops on the new curricula will be held soon.

State testing: Scores have been received and students did great.

Project Art: Project Art is coming back. Students' ProjectArt experience will culminate in a showcase that parents can watch.

Field trips: This year, each grade will go on a minimum of three field trips.

Ms. Koatz -

State testing in grades 3, 4, and 5. This is the first year that grade 5 state tests are required to be done on the computer. Grade 5 testing will likely be done on a different day than grade 3 and 4 testing. Our school has a subscription to TypingClub, which is accessible through teachHub, to help students learn to type and prepare for the online test.

Workshops: There are several upcoming workshops. The dates will be sent out in the parent coordinator's weekly emails. On September 29th there will be a workshop on supporting your child at home which will go over the parent handbook. In October there will be a workshop on middle school admissions. Also in October, there will be a fall craft workshop at PS 144.

Garden: Thank you to parent volunteers. We are in contact with a new vendor for the garden.

Treasurer's Report - Rachel Bialik

The budget for the 2023-2024 school year was presented and approved with majority vote. We have several fundraisers planned, such as the plant sale, picture day, restaurant fundraisers, and the teachers' raffle. Fundraisers will provide funding for events such as the BMX bike show and other assemblies. We have also allocated some funds for possible events such as a cooking

lab and Family Fitness Funday. Our anticipated income for the year is \$80,100, and our current anticipated expenses are \$67,000.

Parent Questions: A question was raised about leftover funds. Leftover funds from the previous year are carried over to the current year. We have money leftover in the budget that was received from the city for Covid vaccinations. To spend money that is not currently accounted for in the budget, the expenditure has to be proposed and voted on by the PA body. Teacher reimbursement: teacher reimbursement was not included in this year's budget since we will be returning to our regular teacher appreciation week events. Funding for field trips: this is handled with the individual classroom teachers.

<u>Committees to be formed:</u> Committees are needed for the Halloween Party, 5th grade committee and International night. Sign-up sheet have been provided. Additionally, volunteers are needed for picture day.

<u>Update on upcoming events:</u> Our first restaurant fundraiser is at Jersey Mike's from September 21st to the 24th. The BMX bike show is coming up on September 28th. This year the bike show has an anti-bullying and bike safety message. Picture day will be on October 2nd and 3rd, and the Halloween Party will be at the end of October.
