DreamBox Learning Math at Home review

Ms. Koatz discussed the DreamBox program the school is currently testing. The trial period is over in February. If it is successful, as current feedback suggests, the school will purchase it so students can have access to it all year long (including in the summer). It is available for K-8. It is not just for children that are struggling with math but for all children. The program adjusts to your child's proficiency level and lets them move ahead. The research behind DreamBox shows it improves children's skills. The school recommends using the program at home for about one hour a week. The form and email Ms. Koatz sent out shows how parents can keep track of their children's progress. The school can monitor your child's progress but cannot see if parents are tracking their children.
