### **SLT Report- Ariana:**

<u>C. Koatz – CBT (Computer Based Testing) Field Tests</u> Ms. Koatz joined the meeting and gave an
overview of the CBT system. NYSED (NYS Educational Department) is transitioning grades 3-8 from paper
based testing to computer based testing. There is no specific ETA on when the testing will be computer
based. Questar (the vendor awarded the contract by the NYSED to develop the new system) is developing

the tool and the field tests will "assess the benefits and drawbacks of the student testing experience on the computer." The 4th grade at PS196 is participating in Math constructed response field testing on Thursday, May 31st. The test will be limited to one 45 minute session (for each testing group). The results will not be reported to the school or the students. The purpose of the field test is to check the "quality and appropriateness of test items." The test will be "comparable to the paper based field test in length and question type." All testing will be online in addition to accommodations being made for students IEPs. The results will not affect your child's grades in any way as this a "no-stakes" testing environment.

- <u>Facial Recognition Software/School Camera</u> Mrs. Migliano will put in a request for facial recognition software to be part of the new school cameras. She was told she has to work with the police department to get a proposal together for the system.
- <u>RESO-A Funding</u> Funding used for school infrastructure improvement which includes technology projects, whiteboards, auditorium upgrades, playgrounds, wireless connections, etc. The funding is sponsored by Borough Presidents and City Council members. Requests for specific items and amounts of funding happen at the beginning of the year. If funding is awarded, proposals/bids are put together. The best bid wins, construction begins. After the work is completed any extra funds return to the state.
- Homework Policy During State Exams Parents have asked that homework not be assigned during state
  testing days and other tests and projects be given enough time to work on after the tests are over. This is
  being discussed with the teachers.
- <u>Unfinished Business</u> A request was made by Mrs. Migliano, for metal doors to replace the doors that exist currently.
- The projection for the 2018-2019 school year is 1,009 students, which will put the school in the range to acquire another security guard. Mrs. Migliano is in contact with Sgt. Heines at the local precinct and will ask about this item.
- Mrs. Migliano is looking to have two cluster teachers for science next year (K-2 and 3-5) depending on the budget.
- Mrs. Migliano is trying to get Related Service Providers sent to the annex to work with children's IEPs so the children will not have to travel back and forth between buildings.
- Mrs. Migliano stated she hoped any parents concerned with school safety would attend the meeting on April 24th. Notices have been sent out to parents in their children's folders as well as announced by Ellen Maurer during her weekly calls
