Treasurer's Report

- -Tita reviewed and explained the budget line by line. Anticipated Income, anticipated expenses and new difference line for clearer understanding of budget.
- Board received and addressed questions for some of the events: 5th grade budget, Teacher's reimbursement, Library books, Family Fitness Funday, Assemblies.

SLT Report

-Garden/Composting

The school is putting forward \$2500 to support the garden and the PA is voting on putting forward an additional \$2500 - \$5,000 for Farmer Fred and the lower grades (K& 1) will get sessions this year.

The Wellness Council secured additional funding for \$125K from Assemblyman Hevesi for an outdoor classroom and green house.

-Water Filters for Classroom Fountains

Currently discussing what to request on the Participatory Budget e.g., bathroom updates as well as water filters for classrooms. People need to get out and vote.

-Combined Upper/Lower Grade Gym Classes

A parent voiced a concern about lower grades and sharing gym with the upper grades. This year most shared gym classes will be only one grade at a time.

-Busing for Older Children

The DOE does not currently offer busing for 3rd-5th graders. In previous years, parents have gotten together and hired their own private bus.

-Unfinished Business

Fifth graders will not have a library period but do have "open access" meaning they can visit the library when they have time.

- -Gym requirements are 120 minutes of movement gym classes, yoga classes and movement in the classroom e.g., Go Noodle, Brain Breaks, Move to Improve.
- -Parent coordinator candidates are currently being interviewed.
- -New addition to the school is tentatively scheduled for completion in 2021. Current plan includes 10 additional classrooms and 4 offices.
