

Parents Association of P.S. 196Q 71-25 113th Street, Forest Hills, NY 11375 Minutes of PA Meeting – Tuesday, April 20th 2021 - Virtual

Mary Pierantoni (Parents Coordinator)

- Candidate forums on Thursday (4/22) and Friday (4/23) both @ 6pm. Serving on citywide education council

- Voting May 1 to May 11
- Mary sent email out to register for forum

- ON 4/26, parents can sign up for Summer Rising Program. It is 8am – 6pm. PS196 isn't on the list of schools hosting it at this time.

Susan Migliano (Principal)

- Receiving emails about going 5 days. School is considering it but currently has an A/B plan in place for now. Decision to go to 5 days depending on guidance from DOE about the 3 ft rule. If it is 6 ft distancing rule, 5 days cannot be done. Regarding breakfast, still unclear how this would work. Lunch has been solved to accommodate the influx of formerly remote kids (33 changed from remote to in person). For lunch, half the kids will eat indoors and half will eat outdoors if weather allows.

- Confirmation of 3 ft rule was supposed to be early in April but not communicated from DOE yet.

- Teachers union so far has not approved the 3 ft rule yet, hence the inability to have a final decision at this time.
- Can't compare nearby schools because of the difference in student and teacher census. This factors into the logistics.
- Currently 386 students are currently in blended/in-person @ PS196
- Central (Mayor-Chancellor's office) make the decision on 3 ft rule

- As of now, PS196 is not slated to host the Summer Rising program. That may change when updated lists are sent out

Maria Romero (ASP Director)

- Full day program is at FHJC, starting at 8am. Also has afternoon program. This is planned to run this was until June

- Available to all PS196 students and their siblings
- Likely that Fall ASP will be back to usual but still in planning stages. As more information about Fall comes to fore, Maria will reach out and provide information for registration over the summer
- Remote students can participate on an as needed basis

Ellen Chu (SLT representative)

- PS196 got back the money we were being asked to pay to DOE for registration. Mrs. Migliano is working out how to spend that money for the school, some of which cannot be rolled over to the next year.

- PS196 per:

> Reading (we use Teachers College) was 59.5% in Nov reading on or above grade level (level 3 or 4, respectively), 72.8% in Jan, 76.8% in March. 27.2%/39.6%/46.9% respectively in children with ESL. 31.7%/47.9%/49.6% respectively in children with disability.

> Math (GoMath): 49.7% (in levels 3/4), compared to 26.6% in Sept. 52.6%, xxx. 42% compared to xxx

- No difference in performance of blended vs remote students.
- NYS testing is happening this week. 85 remote students are coming in for the test (26/37/42 in 3rd/4th/5th grades)

Cigall Goldman (Wellness Cmte)

- Tomorrow will be a movement and relaxation session. It is earth themed.
- Fewer activities now as weather is getting warmer and kids are spending more time outdoors

- Teacher gifts: We budgeted \$10,000 and spend \$6,700 in December leaving us with \$3,300. We now need \$3,400 that we would like to take that money from the other line items were the money wasn't spend. PA body gets to vote on whether to approve this money either at our next meeting or an emergency meeting.
